- _____ The day's title is written and highlighted at the top-center of the odd-numbered page.
- _____ A 2-inch margin line is drawn for Cornell Notes.
- _____ The title and page number are written in the Table of Contents.
- _____ The standard number(s) is/are written in the upper right corner.
- _____ Notes are taken during lecture in black ink - paraphrase!
- _____ All IDs are highlighted in the notes.
- _____ All vocab is highlighted in the notes.
- _____ One "*on-the-surface*" question has been written for each bullet. All must begin with *How* or *Why*. One may begin with *What*.
- _____ The answers for all "*on-the-surface*" questions are underlined in the notes using blue ink.
- _____ All vocab is highlighted and defined using the WH9H glossary.
- _____ The question of the day has been answered by a short, hand-written paragraph of 2-4 sentences. Q/A written in opposites: blue/black.
- _____ The "*visual of the day*" is added to the left-side with a proper and complete label. Get your visuals from the WH9H website!
- _____ A portrait has been added for each person who is an ID in the notes, and each portrait has been identified by name.
- _____ **EXTRA CREDIT:** At least one additional, **RELEVANT** visual (**NOT A PORTRAIT**) has been added, and given a proper and complete label.
